

Cookies

Below are instructions that may be of help when troubleshooting technical issues you may be encountering when using Pure Michigan Talent Connect. Please note that the steps may vary, depending the version of the browser you are using.

Internet Explorer (IE)

1. In Internet Explorer, click the Tools button, click Internet Options, and then click the Privacy tab.
 2. Move the slider down to enable All Cookies. On this setting, websites will be able to store cookies on your computer.
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Firefox

1. At the top of the Firefox window, click on the **Tools** menu and then select **Options**.
 2. Select the **Privacy** panel.
 3. Set **Firefox will:** to **Use custom settings for history**.
 4. Check mark **Accept cookies from sites** to enable Cookies, and uncheck it to disable them.
 - If you are troubleshooting problems with cookies, make sure **Accept third party cookies** is also check marked.
 5. Choose how long cookies are allowed to be stored:
 - Keep until: **they expire**: Each cookie will be removed when it reaches its expiration date, which is set by the site that sent the cookie.
 - Keep until: **I close Firefox**: The cookies that are stored on your computer will be removed when Firefox is closed.
 - Keep until: **ask me every time**: Displays an alert every time a website tries to send a cookie, and asks you whether or not you want to store it.
 6. Click **OK** to close the Options window
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Chrome

To enable cookies in Chrome:

1. Click the Chrome menu icon.
2. Select **Settings**.
3. Click **Show advanced settings** near the bottom of the page.
4. Click **Content settings** in the "Privacy" section.
5. Select **Allow local data to be set** to allow both first-party and third-party cookies. If you only want to accept first-party cookies, check the box next to "Block all third-party cookies without exception."
